

Jonathan Haydn-Williams' Charges for Appointments as Mediator

Jonathan aims to charge for acting as mediator on a basis that is proportionate to the dispute. The main factor will be the amount in dispute, but other factors such as the extent of documentation or number of parties may be relevant. Some disputes may not involve a money claim.

The following are his guideline fees based on the total claimed by way of claim and counterclaim in a dispute involving two parties. A precise quote will be given on a tailored basis for each mediation, taking into account all relevant factors:

<u>Amount in dispute</u>	<u>Fees charged per party</u>	<u>Hours of mediation (up to)</u>
Up to £5,000	£150	3 hrs (+ 1 hr preparation)
£5,001 - £15,000	£200	4 hrs (+ 1 hr preparation)
£15,001 - £25,000	£300	5 hrs (+ 1.5 hrs preparation)
£25,001 - £50,000	£450	6 hrs (+ 2 hrs preparation)
£50,001 - £100,000	£675	7 hrs (+ 2.5 hrs preparation)
£100,001 - £250,000	£1,000	8 hrs (+ 3 hrs preparation)
Over £250,000	quote given on application	

Additional hours of preparation and mediation are charged in units of $\frac{1}{4}$ hour, at a guideline hourly rate based on the fees quoted divided by the hours of mediation and preparation stated, e.g. if the amount in dispute is up to £5,000, the guideline hourly rate per party for additional work would be £150 divided by 4 = £37.50.

VAT, travelling (outside M25) and out of pocket expenses will be charged in addition.
